

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS

We used to recommend 2 tsp. (10 ml.) per gallon in one treatment or 1 tsp. (5 ml.) per gallon in 2 treatments. Lately, however, we've gotten a lot of reports of leaf burn. Our original dosage recommendations were based on strains that were popular in Humboldt about 4 years ago. Strains have changed so our dosing instructions have changed. Most instances of severe leaf burn can be traced back to severe over fertilizing prior to applying Gravity. Since Gravity causes a sudden uptake of nutrients it's important to wash out excess fertilizer prior to application.

NEW FEEDING SCHEDULE

Gravity is usually applied about 3 weeks before finish. Plants should be healthy with no signs of stress. Prior to applying Gravity plants should be thoroughly soaked with plain water. Gravity is best applied alone although it's okay to use molasses or products like Sweet or Earth Juice Catalyst. If you've been using Purple Maxx, it's okay to add it to the plain water at 1 tsp. (5 ml.) per gallon.

SOIL APPLICATION:

Use 1/2 teaspoon (2 1/2 ml.) per gallon of water and apply 2 to 4 consecutive waterings. Usually 2 doses should be sufficient. If growing under HPS, it's best to raise lights 6" and keep room under about 82 degrees F.

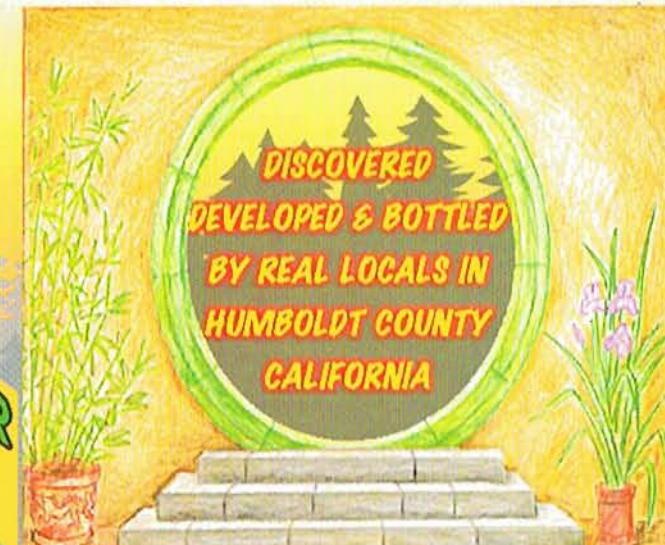

HYDROPONIC APPLICATION

Since hydroponic feeding is so much more efficient than soil feeding, the effective dose is lower.

The key to success in hydro is to keep the dosage low and run it for various lengths of time.

Start out using 1-2 ml. per gallon and run for 2-3 days with plain water or with molasses, Purple Maxx, EJ Catalyst, etc. If no signs of stress are observed then continue to run. Depending on the strain it may take 5-12 days to get maximum results.

We knew we had a winner when a wild-eyed, excited customer came in and begged me to sell him all the samples I had for \$65 apiece! Too bad I was almost out. ;-P

Meanwhile, Ken's friend in Santa Rosa ended up with plants that were so top heavy that they all fell over so he started calling the product "The Gravity." When it came time to design a real label for the product I decided to name it Gravity in honor of the people who discovered what it could really do.
